The workshop will include demonstrations, critiques and lots of one-on-one individual help. Whether you've never tried painting cityscapes or are an experienced urban painter, this workshop will be an invaluable opportunity to gain new painting insights.

John Salminen was born and raised in St. Paul, Minnesota. He earned his Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree from the University of Minnesota.



John is a signature member of many art societies, including the American Watercolor Society, the National Watercolor Society, The Watercolor USA Honor Society, the Transparent Watercolor Society of America, Allied Artist and Watercolor West. He has been appointed an honorary member of the Jiangsu Watercolor Research Institute in China. In addition, he has been honored with Master Status in the Transparent Watercolor Society of America and inclusion in the American Watercolor Society's Dolphin Fellowship.

John has won more than 175 awards in national and international exhibitions. While perhaps best known for his realistic urban landscapes, John has also gained recognition for his mixed medium abstract paintings.

John's work has been featured in many national and international magazines and books. He is listed in Who's Who in American Art and in Who's Who in America.

He lives and works in Duluth, Minnesota with his wife, Kathy.
